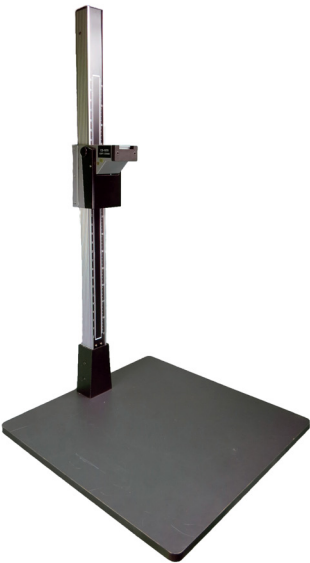

Parts Included



(1) Copy stand



(1) Adjustable Rail



(2) Short Screws



(4) Long Screws



(1) Bubble Level

Installing the baseboard

Please look carefully at the pictures so you fully understand the components and their proper positions. Your purchase should include:

1. One baseboard
2. One upright or column post
3. One adjustable rail

First step: Mount the upright to the baseboard



Top view



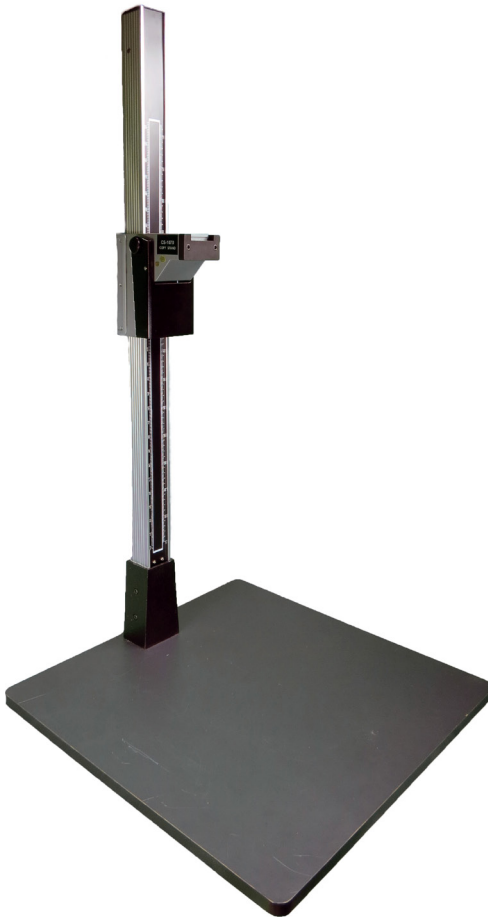
Bottom view

Screws will be attached from the bottom of baseboard into the upright.



- Take the 4 long screws and place them through the holes of the bottom side of the baseboard. Slide the upright into the screws. Tighten with fingers and then use the proper tool to secure the upright to the baseboard.

- After you mount the baseboard and the column post you copy stand should look as follows.



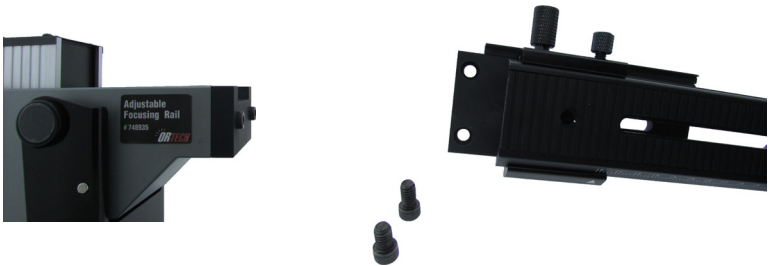
- Now you just need to mount the adjustable rail to the copy stand.

Installing the adjustable rail

- To install the adjustable rail to the copy stand do the following:



- Mount the adjustable rail on top of the copy stand by inserting the 2 short screws inside the two holes like the following picture.



- The adjustable rail with the copy stand assembly should look like the following picture.

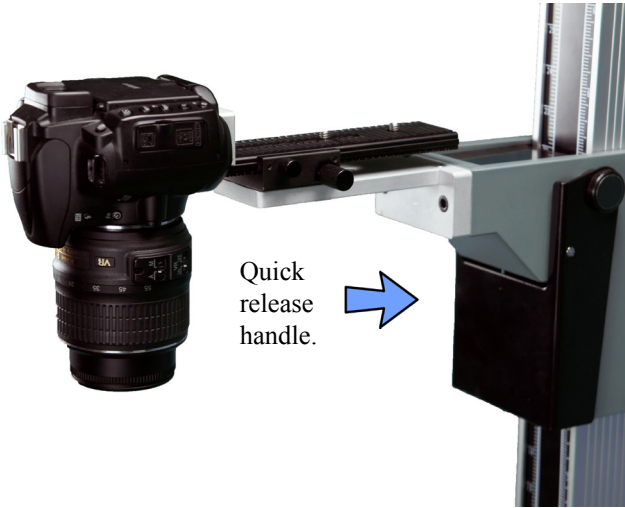


- Finally, mount the camera on the ballhead.

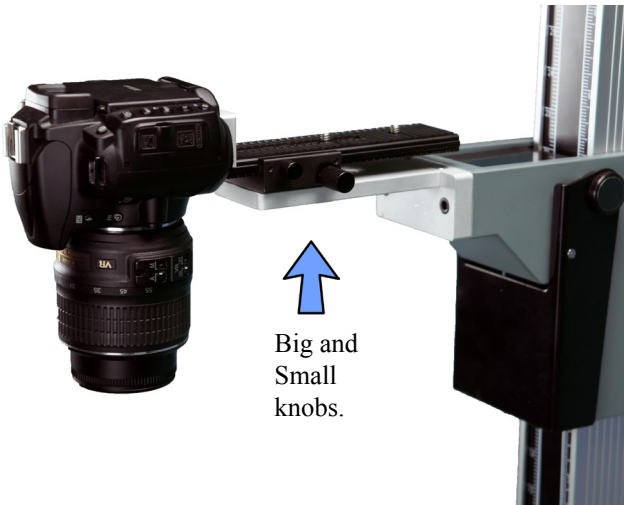


Using the copy stand with adjustable rail

- To move the camera up and down just grasp the quick release handle and squeeze, move into position, and release.



- To move the camera to the front or to the back of your lighting system use your adjustable rail, untight the small knob, move into position with the big knob, and then tight the small knob again.



- You can also move your camera in angle, to do that you just need to untight the knob at the top, move at the angle that you need, and then tight the knob back.
