Installing the Linkage Bracket


Please read each of the steps and look at the images for visual guidance. Some of the newest eBoxes have the Linkage Bracket already installed.

• Identify the parts.


The new version of the boxes listed before came with bar holders on the left, please verify that your box has this feature.



 Slide the vertical ½ inch STEEL BAR inside the TOP BAR HOLDER and before reaching the BOTTOM BAR HOLDER, slide the LINKAGE BRACKET first and then slide the NYLON WASHER with the thumb screw.



Slide the ½ inch STEEL BAR inside the BOTTOM BAR HOLDER, then tight
it gently with the 4 SET SCREWS (two for the BOTTOM BAR HOLDER and
two for the TOP BAR HOLDER) using the supplied ALLEN KEY (Please do
not over tight).



 The final assembly should look like this picture. Please remember to reinstall the vinyl caps at the ends of the steel bar.



Mount your camera on the LINKAGE BRACKET by screwing it on the ¼ inch mini ball head located at the end of the bracket (clockwise direction).
Hold tight your camera with one hand and screw the mini ball head with the other.



• The camera mounted on the LINKAGE BRACKET should look like the following picture.



Using the Linkage Bracket at the top opening

The Linkage Bracket can be moved to the top of the Lighting System so you can photograph items from that angle without any difficulty or effort.

Please read each of the steps and look at the images for visual guidance


Dismount your camera from the LINKAGE BRACKET by unscrewing the ¼ inch mini ball head located at the end.



 Unscrew the 4 SET SCREWS (two on the BOTTOM BAR HOLDER and two on the TOP BAR HOLDER) using the supplied ALLEN KEY.



 Slide out the vertical ½ inch STEEL BAR from the BOTTOM BAR HOLDER and then take out the NYLON WASHER with the thumb screw and the LINKAGE BRACKET respectively.



 Once you have detached the LINKAGE BRACKET and the NYLON WASHER, you need to reinstall the STEEL BAR back to the original position and tight it with the 4 SET SCREWS (two for each BAR HOLDER). Please do not over tight.



 Now, Slide the NYLON WASHER with the thumb screw first, then slide the LINKAGE BRACKET on top of the STEEL BAR and reinstall the vinyl caps at the ends of the steel bar.



Mount your camera on the LINKAGE BRACKET by screwing it on the ¼ inch mini ball head located at the end the final assembly should look like the following picture.





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
